The Registered Trade Skills Pathway (RTSP) Program enables eligible individuals within the Manufacturing/Engineering industry to have their existing skills recognised to gain a trade qualification.

The program includes Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) to assess and recognise existing skills and provides the gap training required to complete the qualification.
