SKILLS ASSESSMENT AND GAP TRAINING PROGRAM

The Skills Assessment and Gap Training (SAGT) Program enables eligible individuals to have their existing skills recognised to gain a trade qualification.

Funded by the Department of Education and Training (DET), the program uses Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) to assess and recognise existing skills and identifies the gap training required to complete the qualification. Participants are required to pay the gap training cost which is \$1.60 per nominal hour for each unit of competency.
