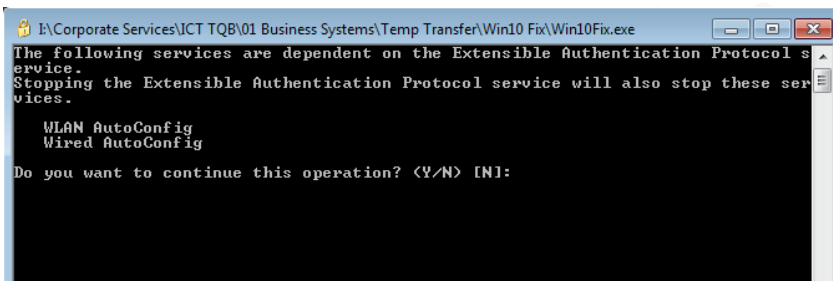


Steps to Connect to TAFE_OPEN

1. If you are using Windows 10 please download the following security certificate update. Navigate to the following website and download this update http://apps.tafebrisbane.edu.au/Win10_Fix/win10Fix.exe

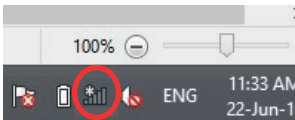
NOTE - This update is only for Windows 10 Laptops and Surface tablets, it is not required for Windows Phones.

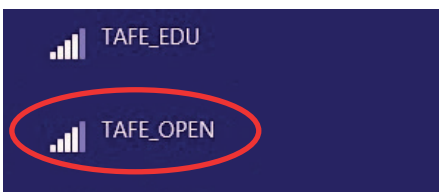


Type 'y' at the prompt, the application will update the required certificate and then stop and restart the networking services

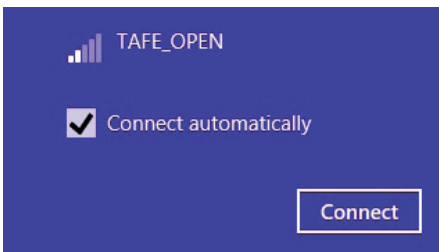
2. Click on the wireless network icon in the notification area of the status bar (bottom left of the screen)



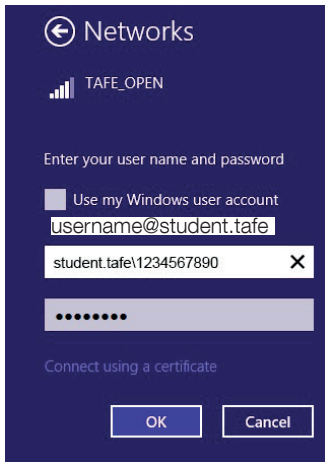
3. Select **TAFE_OPEN**



4. Tick the **Connect automatically** checkbox



5. For Students: Enter username starting with **username@student.tafe** and enter password
For Staff: Enter username starting with **username@staff.tafe** and enter password



6. Windows 8.1 **Only** - Trust **BTQADMCS1-CA** certificate, if asked for.
Windows 10 received the updated certificate in the above patch

Username format:

Prefix	Username Example
username@student.tafe	123456789@student.tafe
username@staff.tafe	bloggsj@staff.tafe

The device should now successfully connect to the TAFE_Open wireless network
